HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a lower height division than the AKC mandated height. 24C"	---	Dogs who measure into the 24-inch regular jump height division are not eligible to enter 24-Choice.

NOTE: Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height division may optionally enter in 24-Choice (24C) jump height at their discretion.

😊 Simplified Jump Height Card Process 😊

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. *It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.*

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

MOVE UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the Oct. 27th trial no later than Oct. 22nd at 6pm.

Day to Day Move ups will be accepted but must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class (STD & JWW).

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor. **Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during walkthroughs.** All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc. Bitches in Season and dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury will have the entry fees refunded by way of vouchers for upcoming agility events (minus the AKC and trial secretary fees.) A written letter must be given to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the day of the trial. A written letter from a vet is required.

In the event of a dog's death, the entry fees (minus the AKC and Trial Secretary fees) will be refunded by way of vouchers for future events.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Flat Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH/PACH Rosettes and a MACH/PACH bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH or PACH title at this trial. High scoring junior rosettes, new title rosettes, and Double Q ribbons are also offered. All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed.

No Early Setups.
- **No Smoking on Trial Grounds**
All smoking must be done in individual cars or self-contained RVs. Please dispose of cigarette butts.
- **Little Creek Reservoir Park** is immediately across the street from the site with nice walking paths (~ 2 miles wooded along the reservoir), well-maintained public restrooms, dog-friendly (on leash)
NO WADING OR SWIMMING ALLOWED FOR PEOPLE/DOGS.

From the South via Rt I-64 North

- I-64 West toward Richmond, Take Exit 231 A (Norge/Toano)
- At the end of the ramp, turn RIGHT on SR 607 (Croaker Rd)
- Go 1.5 miles to light. Turn RIGHT on Route 60 West (Richmond Rd)
- Go 1.8 miles. Turn LEFT on SR 610 (Forge Rd)
- Go 2.2 miles. Turn LEFT on Lakeview Dr
- Go ~ 1/8 mile to WHITE FENCING, gravel drive on LEFT



From the North via I-64 South (from the Northern VA and Richmond Areas)

- I-64 East to Williamsburg/Norfolk/Hampton to Exit 227 (Toano/Williamsburg)
- Turn RIGHT at the end of the ramp onto SR 30 Old Stage Highway
- Keep straight for ~ 3 miles (Road changes names to Richmond Rd Rt 60)

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
