• **Wed Afternoon – Set Up from 2pm - 6pm for all willing to help with event set up.**

- Helpers may come in, lay their tarps down to reserve that "prime" spot and then come help with the ring set up. Vouchers will be provided for set up helpers.

• **THURS – No Setup - Building CLOSED and Locked**

• **FRIDAY** – Equipment will arrive at 6am on Friday.

Equipment helpers and course builders please be ready to help at 6am. General set-up/crating at 7am.

The center will open at 7am all days for exhibitors.

TRIAL SITE

These trials will be held in a large indoor fan-cooled arena on dirt. There is plenty of room for crating indoors, and lots of grassy area to walk dogs. A concession stand will be open during trial hours, and there are a number of restaurants and fast food establishments nearby. Clemson restaurants and lodging establishments are roughly 4 miles to the west; Anderson restaurants and lodgings are roughly 8 miles to the east.

GENERAL

- Please be considerate of other exhibitors. Do not let your dog urinate inside the arena, on garbage cans, equipment etc., someone has to handle these!
- **No smoking/vaping within 50' of the building.**
- Flexi-Leads **MUST** be kept at the **2' LOCKED** position when used **IN** and **NEAR** the building.
- Please pick up after your dogs so we can continue to use this wonderful facility. Exhibitors caught not cleaning up after their dog will be asked to leave the trial grounds. No refund will be given if this occurs.
- Canaan Dog Club of America will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

CHECK-IN and MEASURING

We will not be using Armband labels at these trials. However, you will need to know your Armband number in order to do an At Trial move-up. Please bring a printed or an electronic copy of your trial confirmation so you will have your armband number with you.

We are scheduled to have three Volunteer Measuring Officials (VMO) at our trials. All dogs needing to be measured must be measured by a VMO prior to running. Measurements will take place from 7:15am to 7:45am each day. Additional measurements during the trial are subject to VMO availability.

DO NOT RISK A Q – GET MEASURED BEFORE RUNNING

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail preferred) prior to 6pm on Monday, November 23, 2020.

Be sure that I have acknowledged receipt of your move-up. Please preface all correspondence with "CDCA" in the Subject line. **Day to Day move ups must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class (STD, JWW, and FAST).**

RUNNING ORDER & SCHEDULE

There will be NO briefing for Ex/MAS and Premier classes. Judge’s briefings will be for Novice, Open classes only.

Ex/MAS STD and Ex/MAS JWW

walkthrus will be split as follows:

4” - 12” Walk1 – Walk2 / Run All

16” Walk – Run

20” – 24C” Walk1- Walk2/Run ALL

NOTE: When Class walkthroughs are split into 2 walks there will be no 5 minute break until the first dog

** Open and Novice JWW classes take precedence over EX/MAS STD class.

All other classes will have one walkthru.

Please be sure to check the Ring START times daily as they are different to accommodate the classes

If you think you will miss your scheduled walkthru due to a conflict, walk with an EARLIER jump height!

For those with conflicts, you are asked to please walk the courses with an EARLIER height group if the conflict would mean you can't walk with your height class. You can also run at the end of the earlier height group or at the beginning of your height group instead of at the end.

All conflicts must be approved by the judge.

We realize that handlers with multiple dogs will have some conflicts.
Please be sure to mark yourself as a conflict using Agility Gate and/or notify the Gate stewards in **BOTH RINGS**.

NEW - The arena has designated traffic flow patterns for One Way traffic at some doors & at the stairs.
Be sure to allow time to reach the rings following the posted routes.

COVID Precautions and Guidelines

Please be aware that by attending this trial, you are putting yourself at greater risk of exposure to COVID-19 than if you stayed at home. The Canaan Dog Club of America (CDCA) will be following state and local mandates at the time of our indoor event. Those mandates are listed below and will be posted around the building. In addition, we have put together a list of rules and guidelines that will be used at our trial to do our best to keep everyone safe.

Anyone who does not abide by the rules and guidelines will be asked to leave and will not receive a refund.

By signing your entry form, you and any family you bring with you, agree to follow these rules. Failure to do so will result in expulsion from the trial and the T. Ed Garrison Arena with no refund of entry fees or RV/camping fees.

- Signed COVID waivers are required in order to run at these trials. If you have not provided a signed waiver you will not be allowed to run.
- There will be NO SPECTATORS ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING. Please do not ask any family or friends to come and watch.
- Masks MUST be worn at all times in the building and within 10 feet of the building. Once you are outside and 10 feet away from the building, you may lower your mask as long as you maintain proper social distancing measures. If you fail to abide by this rule, you will be asked to leave the trial without a refund. You may lower your mask for your run but it must be put back on upon exiting the ring.
- Walkthroughs will be reduced in numbers to allow for social distancing. While walking, please be considerate and follow 6' social distancing rules. WEAR YOUR MASK DURING WALKTHROUGHS
- We will allow crating in the building. We do encourage you to crate out of your car, set up EZ-UP's, etc. You may crate together as a family but please keep 6 feet between setups. Please do not make us have to police crating.
- Please keep the bleacher seats for watching the ring before your run – not socializing. Sit in a socially distanced manner and use your best judgment.
- Only workers, club members, judges and the next 5 handlers due in the ring will be allowed on the floor of the arena while rings are running.
- Follow all posted signs for One Way traffic at doors and stairs and at concessions.
- We need to limit the # of people in the building. If you have completed your runs and are not working, please exit the building to reduce the # of people in the building at one time.

APPS to Help Keep Exhibitors Informed.

We will be using two apps to help manage the trial. Remind and Agility Gate. Please download Agility Gate to your devices. You do not need to download the Remind app to get the text notifications. Please keep in mind that these apps are only an aid. Exhibitors are still responsible for arriving on time for their walk-throughs and runs.

REMIND APP

We will be using the Remind app during the weekend to send announcements in order to keep exhibitors informed. Announcements will be sent to your phone as text messages. For example, when each course is being built, course ready to walk, last dog running before next walkthrough, Ribbons available for pickup, etc. We will also be sending pictures of course times and the trial results. The link will take you to the **CDCA Nov 27-29 class**. Add your name and phone #. You will get a confirmation code to verify your phone #. You will then be prompted to add info about yourself. Select **STUDENT**. If you have problems joining the class, let us know and send us your phone number and we will add you to the class.

AGILITY GATE APP

We will also be using the Agility Gate app. This allows exhibitors to check in for their runs through the app and to follow along by looking at the gate sheets as dogs are crossed off when they run.

To use the Agility Gate app, please download it from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.

Using Agility Gate you can:

- Check in your dog
- Mark your dog ABSENT
- Mark a CONFLICT
- Follow in real time to see who is running in the ring using the running order. On the app you can see as the gate steward marks each dog on the line the same way you would see it on the paper gate sheets. You will be able to see the whole gate sheet to know how many dogs before your run or how many dogs are left in that class.
- **NEW**: You cannot check-in until the morning of each trial day. This is a precaution so people do not check in and then forget to mark themselves absent if they decide to not run.

Please visit: <http://agilitygate.com/> before the trial to see how it works. Watch the video on that site to see it in action. Once the gate sheets have been uploaded to the app, you will be able to check in.

We will send the access code out by email before the trial.

We will send a code to access the CDCA Trial closer to the trial.

- There will no paper course maps for exhibitors. Course maps will be posted to the GoneDoggin' Agility website and also in the Agility Gate app for each class no later than 9pm. There will also be a paper copy of the maps posted upstairs and down by the rings.
- The running order for the trial will be posted no later than Thursday, Nov 26th. Be sure to download the running order to your devices as there will not be paper Gate sheets to look at. Day to Day Move ups will not be reflected on the posted paper running order.
- For the most current running order for each day, use the Agility Gate App.
- Be mindful and do not crowd the gate steward when they are ringside.

Please bring the following with you to the trial:

- Hand sanitizer/Wipes
- Snacks & Drinks (no MACH/PACH cakes are allowed)
- Mask(s) – You must wear a mask at all times in the building
- Gloves if you wish to wear them.
- Phone/Ipad with a camera, or a camera, for taking pictures of the results, course maps etc.
- A leash that fits in your pocket or around your waist or cross body during your run. Per AKC guidelines: "exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, cross body, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash, this will be scored as "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog was to grab it." A leash-runner will be available for exhibitors who do not wish to carry their leash while on course.

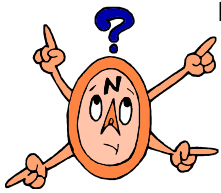

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Note: Follow signs to the arena when you turn on Queen Street - Your GPS will guide you WRONG!



From the South: Take I-85 exit 14 and go left on Hwy 187 North. Proceed 5.9 miles. Turn left on Hwy 76/28 West. Go 2.1 miles and turn LEFT on Queen Street. The T. Ed Garrison Arena will be on your left in .5 miles. Enter at Arena Parking sign.

From the North: Take I-85 exit 19B (Hwy 76/28 West) and go 7.7 miles. Turn LEFT on Queen Street; facility will be on your left in .5 miles. Enter at Arena Parking sign.

From Clemson: From Hwy 123, take Hwy 76/28 East and go 3.3 miles. Turn RIGHT on Queen Street. Arena is on your left in .5 miles. Enter at Arena Parking sign.
