Match Rules & Additional Information

- ❖ No FOOD in Ring.
- ❖ No Prizes or Ribbons.
- ❖ Reasonable Training Allowed in Ring –
 - There shall be no drilling nor intensive or abusive training of dogs on the B-Match grounds.
 - No harsh verbal or harsh physical corrections in the ring – however you can “gently touch your dog”
 - Handler may repeat sequences and/or make up their own courses/sequences in the time allotted per run.
- ❖ All dogs 15 months or older that are registered with AKC are allowed to participate
- ❖ Please list your dog's breed on the entry form
- ❖ Complete a separate form for each entered dog
- ❖ Multiple runs per dog will be in a separate walkthrough group
- ❖ Each run will have 65 seconds max
- ❖ You may bring a toy in the ring but the toy may NOT be thrown
- ❖ No FOOD in Ring..... AGAIN NO FOOD IN RING ☺

DIRECTIONS TO THE EVENT SITE

From Charlotte, Kings Mountain & Gastonia (via I-85): Take I-85 North to Exit 48 (I-485). Turn right on I-485 East, travel to NC 49 (Harrisburg). Turn left on 49 North, through Harrisburg - cross under US 601 (Bridge) and follow NC 49 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

-Or: Take I-485 East to Exit 33 (Hwy. 49N – Harrisburg). Stay on Hwy. 49 North for approximately 13.5 miles. Arena will be on the left.

From Albemarle: Take NC 73 West through Mt. Pleasant. Turn right on NC 49 South, travel 2.9 miles. Arena will be on the right.

From Asheboro: Travel NC 49 South, pass under NC 73 (bridge) Go 2.9 miles. Arena on right.

From Davidson, Cornelius, Huntersville: Take NC 73 East to US 29/Hwy. 601. Turn right, travel 2.2 miles, stay left and follow US 601 to NC 49 North. At red light, turn left onto NC 49 North. Travel 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

From Monroe: Take US 601 North to NC 49 North. Travel 3.2 miles and Arena will be on the left.

From Salisbury: Travel I-85 south take Exit 60. Turn left on Dale Earnhardt/Copperfield Blvd. Follow to NC 3 (approx. 1.5 miles). Turn left at the red light and follow NC 3 to US 601 (approximately go through 6 red lights). Turn left at red light onto NC 49 North and follow NC 49 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

From Columbia, South Carolina: Take I-77 North to I-485 East to Exit 33 (Hwy. 49 North – Harrisburg). Stay on Hwy. 49 North for approximately 13.5 miles. Arena will be on the left.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTREPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed on the reverse side of this entry form. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the forgoing representation and agreement. I (we) agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with all such Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to abide by any decisions made in accord with them.
