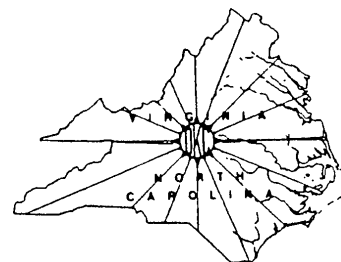

SET-UP - Thursday, November 19th

The trial site will be available for exhibitor set up on Thursday 2 pm to 3 pm. Exhibitors who help the club set up the rings are welcome to set-ups from 11 am to 2 pm. The building will reopen at 6:30 am on Friday.

RUNNING ORDER

Judging will begin at **8:00 am** (briefing 7:40 am) on **ALL DAYS**.

### Friday & Sunday

**LOW to HIGH** (4", 8", 12", 16", 20", 24", 24C")

### Saturday

**HIGH to LOW** (24C", 24", 20", 16", 12", 8", 4")

**Ex/MAS STD and Ex/MAS JWW will be split into 2 groups.**

WALK 1 (4"-8") - WALK 2 (12") -> Walk # 3 (16")

RUN ALL

(20"-24C") WALK1 - WALK 2 -> RUN ALL

There will be no 5 minutes to first dog for classes with multiple walk groups.

**NOTE: Open & Novice FAST will walk together but run back to back.**

**Walk Combined Novice & Open FAST -> Run All Open -> Run All Novice.**

**Ex/MAS FAST will walk-run by itself. T2B will be split into 3 walk groups.**

**Premier classes will have 10 minutes to walk.**

### CLASS ORDER

**FRI:** FAST (Ex/MAS - OPEN/NOV) - PJWW - PSTD - Ex/MAS JWW - Ex/MAS STD

**SAT:** T2B - Ex/MAS JWW - Ex/MAS STD - OPN JWW - OPN STD - NOV JWW - NOV STD

**SUN:** PSTD - PJWW - Ex/MAS STD - Ex/MAS JWW - OPN STD - OPN JWW - NOV STD - NOV JWW

### MOVE-UPS

Move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail preferred) prior to 6pm on Monday, Nov. 16, 2020.

Be sure that I have acknowledged receipt of your move-up!

**Day to Day move ups** (Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday) must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class (STD and JWW).

### MEASURING

**WE ARE SCHEDULED TO HAVE 2 VMOs at this trial.** All dogs needing to be measured must be measured PRIOR to running by a VMO. Measurements will take place before each class. Please allow sufficient time before your dog's run to be measured.

We will not be using Armband labels at these trials. However, you will need to know your Armband number in order to do an At Trial move-up. Please bring a printed or an electronic copy of your trial confirmation so you will have your armband number with you.

**DO NOT RISK A Q  
GET MEASURED BEFORE RUNNING!**

## General Information

- **Park on the gravel only** – not on the grassy areas! Do not park up the small incline by the main door. Dogs need to pee there.
- Please do not walk or relieve your dogs in the landscaped areas near any building. All dogs should be walked behind fencing and not in the front by the offices.

## **Trial Information and Rules**

**You are required to sign the covid19 waiver to participate in the trial.**

- ODAC & DKC will follow all current CDC guidelines for covid19 safety precautions.
- There are real bathrooms with warm water in the upper floor AND on the lower floor by the Standard ring (right outside the door). Please wash your hands.
- **Masks:** You must have a mask on when inside the building. The judge will be wearing a mask while judging. Exhibitors may pull down their masks for running in the ring.
- Please crate out of your car if you can. You can park on either side of the building as long as you are within the gated area. Inside crating will be socially distanced.
- **Spectators are not allowed at this trial.** Please keep the bleacher seats for watching the ring or taping runs – not socializing. Sit in a socially distanced manner and use your best judgement.
- **Check-In** – you can check in with Agility Gate or on the gatesheets in the early check-in binder. The paper gatesheets are a back-up in case the app goes down. Be mindful of crowding at the gateboards when they are ringside.
- Only the **next 6 dogs** in the ring will be allowed in the ring area to keep numbers down. Chairs will be along the wall to stage exhibitors.
- **Course maps** will be posted to the GoneDoggin' Website. [www.GoneDogginAgility.com](http://www.GoneDogginAgility.com) , no later than 9pm the previous evening. The course maps will also be posted by the wall of each ring. Please do not congregate around them. Use your phone camera to take pictures of the maps if you haven't downloaded the maps. We will NOT be using paper course copies.
- **Briefings:** There will only be briefings for Novice & Open STD, JWW, & FAST. No briefings for Ex/MAS, Premier, T2B or EX/MAS FAST. Our judge will be available for questions if needed.
- **Ribbons** will be self-serve on a table for pick-up. **Trial results** will sent out through the REMIND app.
- We will have worker water & Sam's food truck available but not worker snacks.
- You may use a leash that fits in your pocket or around your waist or cross body during your run. Per AKC guidelines: "exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, cross body, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash, this will be scored as "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog was to grab it." A leash-runner will be available for exhibitors who do not wish to carry their leash while on course.

### **APPS to Help Keep Exhibitors Informed.**

We will be using two apps to help manage the trial. Remind and Agility Gate. Please download Agility Gate to your devices. You do not need to download the Remind app to get the text notifications.

### **REMIND APP**

We will be using the Remind app during the weekend to send announcements in order to keep exhibitors informed. Announcements will be sent to your phone as text messages. For example, when each course is being built, course ready to walk, last dog running before next walkthrough, Ribbons available for pickup, etc. We will also be sending pictures of course times and the trial results. The link will take you to the **DKC Nov 18-20 class**. Add your name and phone #. You will get a confirmation code to verify your phone #. You will then be prompted to add info about yourself. Select **STUDENT**. If you have problems joining the class, let us know and send us your phone number and we will add you to the class.

## AGILITY GATE APP

We will also be using the Agility Gate app. This allows exhibitors to check in for their runs through the app and to follow along looking at the Gate sheets as dogs are crossed off when they run.

We will also be tracking with Paper Gate sheets in case of any outages or problems.

To use the Agility Gate app, please download it from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.

Using Agility Gate you can:

- Check in your dog + Mark your dog ABSENT + Mark a CONFLICT
- Follow in real time to see who is running in the ring using the running order. On the app you can see as the gate steward marks each dog on the line the same way you would see it on the paper gate sheets. You will be able to see the whole gate sheet to know how many dogs before your run or how many dogs are left in that class.

We will send the access code out by email before the trial.
