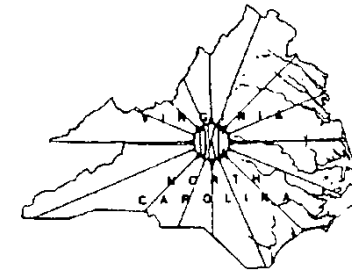

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after Closing

Danville KC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing on June 7, 2022. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Sunday, June 19, 2022 @ 6pm EST will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Sunday, June 19, 2022 @ 6pm EST will receive a full refund.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Make Checks or Money Orders payable to "DKC" only – no cash – and mailed to the trial secretary at the PO Box address ONLY. Be sure to include the correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size. Limit 10 entries per envelope. Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, or fees, nor will telephone or FAX entries be accepted.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid. *****PLEASE WRITE EMAIL ADDRESS LEGIBLY!!!**
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and will result in a \$30 service fee.
- Overnight service **MUST** be mailed through USPS and you **MUST** check **AND** sign the "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED" waiver box, as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information
- Entries not on Official AKC forms or on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current AKC agreement on the reverse side or attached to the entry form
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete, or entries received with insufficient fees
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry
- A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

CONFIRMATIONS

- Confirmations will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active e-mail address or upon specific request.
- A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections.
- Final confirmations of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC form after the closing date.

NOTE: If the exhibitor has not received the Final confirmation within five days of the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH/PACH Rosettes and a MACH/PACH bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH/PACH title at this trial. All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed.

CLASSES OFFERED

Friday – EX/MAS STD, EX/MAS JWW, Premier STD & JWW, & All levels of FAST, regular and preferred

Saturday - All levels STD and JWW, & T2B, regular and preferred

Sunday - All levels STD and JWW plus Premier STD & JWW, regular and preferred

Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

😊 Simplified Jump Height Card Process 😊

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

**It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.
Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

Friday & Sunday LOW to HIGH (4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 24C)

Saturday HIGH to LOW (24C, 24, 20, 16, 12, 8, 4)

Classes will run in the following order:

FRI: FAST (EX/MAS – OPEN – NOV) – Premier JWW - Premier STD - EX/MAS JWW - EX/MAS STD

SAT: T2B - EX/MAS JWW - EX/MAS STD - OPN JWW - OPN STD - NOV JWW - NOV STD

SUN : PSTD - PJWW - EX/MAS STD - EX/MAS JWW - OPN STD - OPN JWW - NOV STD - NOV JWW

MOVE UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing with the information below (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the June 24th trial no later than Monday, June 20th at 6pm.

Day to Day move ups (Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday) must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class (STD and JWW).

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for AKC agility trials.

SITE INFORMATION & RULES

The arena has a dirt surface! The footing packs nicely and is a loamy soil and sand mix designed by Kiser Arena Specialists of Texas.

- No dogs allowed in front of complex near offices or on landscaping
- No dogs allowed in the people part of the building or upper level bathrooms
- Exhibitors are not allowed to park in the asphalt parking lot as those spaces are reserved for the employees. Please park on gravel inside gates on either side of the building.
- **Do not park on the grass** – there is enough room to park on the graveled areas.
- **DO NOT PARK UP THE SMALL HILL. DOGS NEED TO PEE THERE.**
- **RV parking:** spaces are assigned by ODAC.

Please adhere to the following rules while at the site:

- Please do NOT walk your dogs in any area that has been mulched or landscaped to include gardens, flower beds or shrubs.
- Do not allow your dogs to relieve themselves on trashcans and/or the building.
- Flexi-Leads MUST be kept at the 2' LOCKED position when used IN and NEAR the building.
- X-Pens are not allowed in the arena. Baby strollers are NOT allowed by the rings.
- **CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS and YOURSELVES!!!**
- Please be considerate of others. We would like to be invited back!
- No smoking within 20' of the roll-up doors or the entry/exit doors

COVID19 Precautions

- ODAC & DKC will follow all current CDC guidelines for covid19 safety precautions.
- By signing your entry form, you and any family you bring with you, agree to follow these rules. Failure to do so will result in expulsion from the trial and the ODAC Arena with no refund of entry fees or RV/camping fees.
- There are real bathrooms with warm water in the upper floor AND on the lower floor by the Standard ring (right outside the door). Please wash your hands.
- We will have worker water & Sam's food truck available.
- You may use a leash that fits in your pocket or around your waist or cross body during your run. Per AKC guidelines: "exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, cross body, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash, this will be scored as "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog was to grab it." A leash-runner will be available for exhibitors who do not wish to carry their leash while on course.
- Crating inside is allowed but please don't crowd anyone.
- Check in will be **electronic only** using the Agility Gate app.
- There will be a display lpad down by the rings for those exhibitors who do not have Agility Gate so you can view the current running order and check in your dogs.

All Violations will be referred to the Event Committee for a hearing

REFUNDS

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the date of the trial.

Injury/Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund in the form of certificates minus processing fees of **\$10 per run.**

A written vet letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Friday, June 24, 2022.

Validation of the injury/illness must be made by a licensed veterinarian. Requests from chiropractors, massage/physical therapists, etc will not be accepted. Injury/illness refunds will be issued as certificates that can be used towards future Danville KC agility trials.

In the event of a deceased dog, notification (email or written) must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial. A monetary refund will be given minus fees of \$6.50 for first run and \$6 for additional runs (per day) will be given.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

DKC is offering classes FEO in all T2B and FAST classes

- FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).

I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
