During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 200 runs online and 600 runs paper entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

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The waitlist is not extended past closing for this trial.

## REFUNDS

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be on Veterinarian stationary and in the hands of the trial secretary 30 minutes before the start of the trial on Sept. 25, 2017.

## INJURIES

Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury will be given a partial refund minus \$6.50 for the 1<sup>st</sup> run and \$6 for each additional run. A written vet certification, on veterinary letterhead, must be given to the Trial Secretary before September 20, 2017.

Handlers that cannot compete due to an injury will be given a partial refund minus \$6.50 for the 1<sup>st</sup> run and \$6 for each additional run. A written Doctor's certification, on doctor stationary, must be given to the Trial Secretary before September 20, 2017.

- Entries which are illegible or incomplete, or entries received with insufficient fees

## OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

An online worker sign-up link will be available after the trial closes on the GoneDoggin' website.

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open only to Golden Retrievers fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

### ☺ Simplified Jump Height Card Process ☺

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

PVGRC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. PVGRC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the PVGRC or any official thereof.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**Bitches in season** and Dogs under 4 months of age will not be admitted to the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

## RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying flat ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed. Rosettes are offered for any MACH, PACH, PAX, MX, MXJ, MXP, MJP. New Title rosettes are offered for exhibitors earning a new title in Novice, Open and Excellent classes. PVGRC will also offer DoubleQ, TripleQ ribbons and Perfect Score ribbons for Novice, Open and Excellent qualifiers with 100 scores in STD and JWW.

**From Dover, MD:** Rt.13 South – take Rt.13 bypass toward Norfolk. Follow directions above.

**From Norfolk, VA:** Take Business Route 13 North. After passing thru Princess Anne, go 1 mile and turn right on Crown Road – building on left.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
